



PUBLIC NOTICE FOR THE SELECTION OF 15 BENEFICIARIES FOR THE "AMISTADE" PROJECT

Public Notice – Pathways for the Socio-Labour Integration of Third-Country Nationals ESF+ Regional Programme 2021–2027

Priority 3 – Social Inclusion and Combating Poverty

Specific Objective h) ESO 4.8 – Intervention Area 156

1. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

The Temporary Association (ATS) composed of R&M Servizi S.r.l. (Lead Partner) and Alfabeto del Mondo ODV promotes the AMISTADE Project, aimed at fostering the active inclusion and employability of third-country nationals residing in the Ogliastro area. The project seeks to transform situations of vulnerability into economic autonomy through an integrated pathway consisting of guidance, training and work-based traineeships.

2. ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The selection is open to 15 third-country nationals legally residing in the Autonomous Region of Sardinia who have reached the age of majority. The available places are allocated as follows:

- 15 unemployed persons, pursuant to Legislative Decree No. 150/2015.

Preference will be given to applicants who are unemployed or engaged in employment with an annual income below the tax exemption threshold.



3. PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

Selected participants will be required to attend the following compulsory activities:

- Individual Assessment and Career Guidance: preparation of the Individual Action Plan (IAP) and skills assessment.
- Specialised Training (12–18 hours): training modules covering workplace health and safety, HACCP principles and technical-professional skills.
- Complementary Activities: Italian as a Second Language (L2) course (30 hours), Active Citizenship (20 hours) and Digital Skills (25 hours).
- Work Placement (12 months): on-the-job training consisting of 30 hours per week within local companies operating in the tourism, personal care, crafts and environmental maintenance sectors.

4. ALLOWANCES AND SUPPORT MEASURES

- Traineeship Allowance: participants will receive a monthly gross allowance of €500.00, up to a maximum amount of €6,000.00 over a 12-month period.
- Support Measures: according to the needs identified in the Individual Action Plan (IAP), additional support services may be provided, including childcare services (babysitting/day-care), transport assistance and housing support allowances.

5. SELECTION PROCEDURE AND CRITERIA

Applicants will be selected through individual interviews conducted by a multidisciplinary team comprising an Occupational Psychologist, an Intercultural Mediator, and a Career Guidance Counsellor, in order to assess motivation, previous experience, competencies and potential barriers to labour market integration.

Gender Equality: in accordance with the gender mainstreaming principle, at least 40% of the available places (6 out of 15) are reserved for women. Priority will also be given to young applicants and persons in situations of particular vulnerability.



6. MANDATORY PROVISIONS AND FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS

The project guarantees full compliance with the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union and the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD). All project-related communications will be provided in accessible formats.
